About Us

Living Options Devon was founded 30 years ago by Peter Swain OBE. Peter's research in the early 1980s, along with that of those he volunteered with, centered around the extra provision for disabled people and what was available at that time by the statutory and voluntary sectors.

Thirty years on we pride ourselves on still championing the needs and rights of disabled people and members of the Deaf Community (who use British Sign Language (BSL)).

Our aim is for people with disabilities and Deaf people to have the same life chances and opportunities to be active equal members of society.

Every year we support over 6,000 disabled and Deaf people through our projects and services. We offer a range of help and support services for people with a long term health condition, disability and/or who are Deaf, where British Sign Language is their first language.

George's story

George is a British Sign Language user. He was keen to get more fit and healthy. He had experienced communication barriers when trying to participate in sports in the past.

Deaf Get Active has provided accessible activities with communication support and George has tried new sports such as volley ball, yoga and boxing. George feels healthier; he has lost weight and has found his general wellbeing has improved. "It has given me the opportunity to take part in new sports. Opened doors to places."
